HSGS Web Site. <www.rootsweb.com/~usgenweb/mi/iosco/3501hsgs.htm> is the address for our HSGS's indexes on the Internet. The search engine for this site, or all of Michigan or any of the other Michigan's counties is www.rootsweb.com/~usgenweb/mi/search.htm. We currently have 1,141 indexes, 27,564 printed pages, and 1,216,121 name citations indexed: If indexes were printed out they would be 9 feet tall and weight 284 pounds. All these files are on HSGS's master file on our computer's external drive, & the CD we sell, but only about 94% are on the web site (does not include new indexes within the last month, draft indexes not yet finished, & a some random data corrections). Reading HSGS News Letters on the Web. Our newsletters are now in both MSWord and PDF formats. If you still have difficulty opening the newsletter files, realize it may take a long time to open, sometimes 45-60 seconds for MS-Word but usually less time for PDF. If this is not the problem, then down load the free software called "Word Viewer 2003," it is available at <www.microsoft.com/downloads> and then link to this specific software.

Word Viewer 2003 allows you to <u>view, print and copy</u> any MS-Word document, even if you do not have Word installed. However, you cannot edit the document. This replaces all previous Word Viewers.

This program allows you to open all Word documents created by both Microsoft for Windows and for MacIntosh. Beside Word documents it will also open the following formats: Text, Rich Text, Web page formats (htm, html, mht, mhtml), WordPerfect 5.x and 6.x, Works 6.0 and 7.0, and XML.
