The search engine for this site, or all of Michigan or any of the other Michigan's counties is www.rootsweb.com/~usgenweb/mi/search.htm. We currently have 1,179 indexes, 28,205 printed pages, and 1,245,348 name citations indexed: If indexes were printed out they would be 9 feet tall and weight 284 pounds. All these files are on HSGS's master file on our computers external drive, & the CD we sell. But only about 94% are on the web site (does not include new indexes within the last month, draft indexes not yet finished, & a some random data corrections).
